



Karpathians in Canberra

Migrants from the island of Karpathos were the first Greek settlers to establish a parochial brotherhood in Canberra and the surrounding districts in 1959.



The Karpathians of Australia, most of who live in Canberra, were instrumental in the drive to revitalize the island of Karpathos economically and socially.

The Karpathian migration and settlement in Australia took place in two stages:

1. The pre-World War II settlement (1935-1939); and,
2. The post-World War II settlement (1946-1974).

Ninety per cent of the Karpathians who settled in Australia originated from two Karpathian villages – Othos and Pyles – the rest came from such villages as Olympos, Volatha, Menetes, Mesohori, Pehadia and Aperi.

Manolis Tsiragakis was the first Karpathian settler in Australia. He arrived in Sydney in 1932 and worked in the service industry in Newtown. In 1935 Manolis moved to Queanbeyan and worked in the local cafes.

By the end of 1935 three more Karpathians arrived to apply their trades in Queanbeyan. They were Elias Sakellaridis who played a leading role in the establishment of the Greek Community of Canberra and Nicholas Constantinidis and John Kostetsios. They helped trigger an inflow of Greek migrants from Karpathos during the years before World War II.

In 1936, Manolis Tsiragakis invited his brothers Vassilos Tsiragakis and Con Tsiragakis (pictured right) and his compatriot Antonios Papadopoulos to Australia.

Other Karpathian settlers who arrived during the following years included Minas Giogopoulos, Minas Patsourakis with his family (1937), Minas Constantinidis, and the brothers Andreas Papoutsakis, George Papoutsakis and Elias Papoutsakis (1938).

By January 1948, another wave of migrants from Karpathos arrived in Queanbeyan. They were Con Mantinaos, Kalliope Mantinaos, Minas Kamaratos and Minas Economidis. Brothers George, Con and Ron Haniotis, Minas Emmanuel Papadopoulos, Con Hanouzas, Michael Xirakis, John Praxoulis, John Nicholas Economidis and Emmanuel Xirakis arrived between 1950 to 1960.



Con Mantinaos and Con Haniotis came to Canberra in 1951 and George Zamalis, George Leon and Nick Lagonikos in 1952.

A group of community leaders headed by Nicholas Pahos, George Leon and Con Mantinaos provided the impetus that generated the feeling amongst the Karpathian migrants that they needed to be organized collectively in order to assist their native island of Karpathos.

On 25 August 1959 they met in Canberra City at *Leo's Café* (Northbourne Ave, Canberra) which was owned by Con Mantinaos and John Minas Economidis. Following an inspiring meeting they decided to call a general assembly of the 80 families of Karpathians in Canberra and the surrounding districts to notify them about their plans and request their support.

A second interim meeting was organized expanding the number of participating members. The additional community members invited to attend included Emmanuel Xirakis, Antonios Papadopoulos, Minas Constantinidis (pictured right), John Praxoulis, Mihalis Vassiliotis and George Economidis.

The gathering decided to compile an interim Constitution before the First General Assembly of the members, which was called on 20 September 1959.



The Constitutional Committee comprised Antonios Papadopoulos, Minas Constantinidis and John Praxoulis guided by the motivating trio of Nicholas Pahos, George Leon and Con Mantinaos.

The inaugural Assembly took place at the *Blue Moon Café* in Civic and the Constitution of the Karpathian Progressive Association was passed. The members elected were Nicholas Pahos (founding President), Con Mantinaos (Vice President), George Leon (Secretary), George Economidis (Treasurer). Emmanuel Xirakis, Frangios Diakovasilis and Mihalis Vassiliotis were elected Councilors.

Con Mantinaos became the longest serving President of the Karpathian Association, maintaining that leadership role for over 20 years. The Karpathians also acknowledged the contribution of their female members, electing Fina Vassiliotis as their President (1992-1994) and Poppy Vassiliotis (1998-1999, 2007-present).

The Karpathian Progressive Association has served its Island with generous contributions. It was instrumental in assisting its island to refurbish its cathedral, restore its churches and provide for the earthquake victims in Greece.

They also contributed effectively in local Australian appeals offering substantial amounts for the building of the War Memorial in Canberra, the Hellenic Club of Canberra and welfare appeals of the Greek Community of Canberra. Also contributing funds to the Sydney Olympics in 2000 and the Canberra Bushfire appeal in 2003.

The stability of the Karpathian Progressive Association is mainly due to the strong resilience of its members and their social coherence.
